

Directions to SANEC offices, WTC The Hague

Prinses Beatrixlaan 716, The Hague

Upon arrival, please register at the reception desk of WTC The Hague at the E-tower (Prinses Margrietplantsoen 25).

By car

When you use a navigation system please insert the address: Prinses Marijkestraat.

From: Utrecht (A12)

Follow the A12 in the direction of The Hague

When you are on the Utrechtse Baan, turn to Bezuidenhout/Mariahoeve (exit 3).

You will drive through the arch of Nationale Nederlanden and on the end of the exit you should take the right driving lane. Next, you should take the left driving lane. Now the entrance of the plaza is situated on your right hand. To get to the parking of the Prinsenhof, you should go straight ahead and take the first turn to the right. The parking of the Prinsenhof is now on your right hand side.

From: Amsterdam (A4)

Follow the A4 in the direction of The Hague/ Rotterdam

At the exit Leidschendam/Voorburg/Den Haag (exit 8) turn right to the A12.

Follow the A12 to Voorburg/Den Haag.

When you are on the Utrechtse Baan, turn to Bezuidenhout/Mariahoeve (exit 3).

You will drive through the arch of Nationale Nederlanden and on the end of the exit you should take the right driving lane. Next, you should take the left driving lane. Now the entrance of the plaza is situated on your right hand. To get to the parking of the Prinsenhof, you should go straight ahead and take the first turn to the right. The parking of the Prinsenhof is now on your right hand side.

Vanuit Rotterdam (A13)

Follow the A13 in the direction of The Hague.

At exit Rijswijk-centrum (exit 9) take the A4 to Den Haag/Utrecht/Amsterdam.

At the point Prins Clausplein, go to the right driving lane and take the A12.

Follow the A12 in the direction Voorburg/Den Haag.

When you are on the Utrechtse Baan, turn to Bezuidenhout/Mariahoeve (exit 3).

You will drive through the arch of Nationale Nederlanden and on the end of the exit you should take the right driving lane. Next, you should take the left driving lane. Now the entrance of the plaza is situated on your right hand. To get to the parking of the Prinsenhof, you should go straight ahead and take the first turn to the right. The parking of the Prinsenhof is now on your right hand side.

Public Transport

From: The Hague Central Station

By foot: You can reach Prinsenhof by foot in 15 minutes. You will go to the backside of the platform (so not in the direction of the waiting hall). You will take the stairs to the Prins Bernhard viaduct. Then you will walk on the cross-over to the round, white tower. There you will take the stairs down. Follow the sidewalk on the left side of the tracks. You will follow straight ahead and you will reach the Schenkweg, this road will make a turn to the left and will change into the Schenkkade. You will follow this road until you are walking right to the Prinsenhof.

From: The Hague, Station Laan van Nieuw Oost Indie (Laan van NOI)

Prinsenhof is just a five minutes walk. You will leave the station on the side of platform 1. You will take a left and after 50 metres will turn right. After the bridge you will turn left to the Schenkkade until you reach the Prinses Beatrixlaan. The Prinsenhof is located on your right hand side.



RandstadRail

From The Hague Central Station you should take the RandstadRail Zoetermeer/Oosterheem line 3 or 4. This stop is situated above the waiting hall of the central station. When you get out at the 'Prinses Beatrixlaan' (first stop). You have to walk across the building of 'De Belastingdienst' that is situated on your left. When you walk across the building, you will see the Prinsenhof on you lefthand side.

By tram

From The Hague Central Station you can take tramline 2 or 6. After 2 minutes you should get out at 'Ternoot' (first stop). From this stop you will take the stairs down and the Prinsenhof will be situated on you lefthand side.

By bus

From The Hague Central Station you can take bus 39 to Leiderdorp, bus 45 to Leiden or bus 53 to Kruisweg. After 4 minutes, you should get out at stop 'Haagse Poort'. You will find the Prinsenhof on you lefthand side.
