



Tanzania has significant agriculture potential




Global consumption and population growth

US\$300 million upgrade underway


Songwe International Airport opened and operational (March,13)

invested US\$18m in upgrades, with a further US\$80m planned. Yara plan a US\$20m dedicated fertiliser facility

GOVERNMENT COMMITMENT

The Government of Tanzania is an active partner in SAGCOT through a number of key institutions:

Key Government commitments:

- Promotion of global and intra-African trade;
- Establishment of a fast, efficient and transparent system of securing titled land;
- Building on current infrastructure development;
- Promotion of innovative finance;
- Increasing access to agricultural inputs;
- Inter-ministerial Coordination;
- Addressing Taxation Issues and non tariff barriers to trade.

What is next?

- Assets are being promoted to large scale investors in cereals, livestock and sugar
- About 60 Companies and Institutions are partnering with SAGCOT
- A US\$ 50-100million Catalytic Fund design is near completion
- G8 and African Union have committed to Tanzania's Agriculture Growth
- Tanzania Rice, potatoes, horticultural, water, green growth and last mile Partnerships have been formed
- Infrastructure planning and strategy is underway
